Junior College Division: Cowley County, Butler County, Dodge City, Neosho County, others TBA

NAIA/Small College Division: TBA

Running Event Entries: Unlimited entries per school, for all events, including relays.

Field Event Entries: Maximum 4 per school, if you have more than 4 contact the meet director for additional entries.

Scoring:

- The Wichita State Invitational will be scored as two separate meets. The scoring system will be determined based on the number of schools participating.

Entry Fees:

- \$20 per individual athlete if less than 8 total athletes competing.
- \$175 per team, per gender, \$350 total for combined programs.
- Entry fees will be paid via cash or check, the day of the meet to Director of Operations Rob Garcia.
- Please make all checks payable to: Wichita State University – ICAA
- Student athletes and coaches will receive wristbands in their packet. Wrist bands will be used for facility access, as well as hospitality entrance for coaches.

Entry Procedure:

- All entries must be completed online via Direct Athletics.
- Entries are due by Wednesday, January 30th, 2019, no later than 10:00AM.
- Please make sure to have your TFRRS roster set and accurate by the entry deadline.
- Please use actual entry marks from the 2017, 2018 or 2019 Indoor or Outdoor seasons.

Prelims/Finals:

- All running events will be run as finals.
- All horizontal jumps and throwing events athletes will receive three preliminary attempts, with the top 9 athletes advancing to the finals where they will receive three more attempts.

Heat Sheets: The meet director will post heat sheets/starting lists by Wednesday evening, January 30th, on www.goshockers.com under the track and field link "Home Meet Info". It will also be emailed to the address on your direct athletics account.

Relay Cards:

- Please turn into the timing area no later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start time of the relay.
- If more than one relay is entered from an institution, a separate relay card is needed for each relay team.
- Please verify that all relay participants are properly entered into the TFRRS system.

Check-in Procedure:

- Field event athletes must check in 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of their event, at their respective event area.
- Running event athletes must check in 30 minutes prior to the schedule start time of their event. All running event athletes will check in and receive hip numbers on the backstretch on the inside of the track.

Implement Weigh-in: All implements for both the Weight Throw and Shot Put will be checked in near the throwing circle. Please find the weigh-in official one hour prior to the start of the first throwing event of the day.

Coaches Hospitality: We will have a hospitality area for the coaches. Please see our Director of Ops Rob Garcia for more information.

Admission: \$5, kids under 3 are free. WSU students will receive free admission with their Shocker ID.

Facility Restrictions:

- The use of ¼" pyramid spikes will be enforced.
- Warm up must be completed on the track area or in the designated area inside the track. No spikes on the basketball courts!
- No marking chalk, cones, or duct tape will be allowed on the track or runways. Only white athletic tape may be used on the track or runways.
- No electronic devices allowed inside the competition area at any time.

Team Areas:

- Please set up team camps on the pre-determined areas on the inside of the track on the red carpeting.
- Athletes are NOT allowed to put belongings (bags, food, etc.) in the bleachers, as they are reserved for spectators.

Shower Facilities: Showers will be available on the first floor of the Heskett Center, please bring your own towels.

Parking/Directions:

- The Heskett Center is located to the West of Eck Stadium (WSU's baseball stadium) along Perimeter Road.

Athletic Training Room:

- Electric muscle stimulation, ultrasound, hydro-collator, injury ice, ice bags, and emergency equipment will be provided.
- Visiting teams are responsible for bringing their own taping and bandaging supplies.
- A team physician will be in attendance, and EMS will be on call.
